Also, enough turning blanks were included to provide monthly gifts for the Presidential Participation Award (PPA) through 2013. Thus no money will be needed to purchase gifts for the PPA for 2 more years. The S/C also decided that the pen-making equipment and blanks would be made available for use at MOST Days for anyone interested in pen-making. The kits, which amounted to about 100 kits of various type pens, bottle stoppers, lamp pulls, etc, will be sold for \$1 each at MOST Days beginning this month. 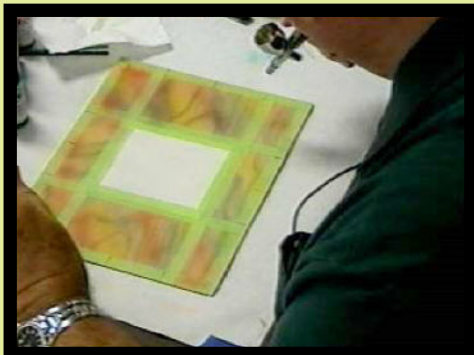
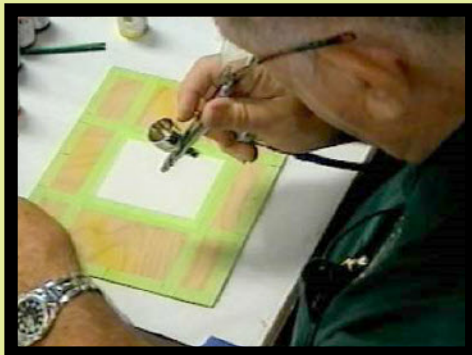
2011 Membership Drive

ETW Silent Auction - April 30, 2011

- Make sure your bid is higher than the last entry, then enter your bid.

NOTE: DO NOT change your earlier bid - enter a new one in the next open space.

- The last entry on the bid sheet wins at the close of the auction.
- When bidding closes, winners will be notified.
- Come to the photo table to pay and collect your item(s).

NOTE: Some items have a minimum bid. Bids below the minimum will not be considered.
