Multiple Spindle Turning by Dennis Ford



I recently took a job turning replacement spindles for a porch railing (113 of them).

I know most of our members would not be interested in turning this many spindles but some may be interested in the sequence that I used. The spindles started as 2-1/2" square by 20" long and were made of Eastern Red Cedar. Each end had a short square section and some simple turned details, a straight round taper made up the center. To avoid spending time measuring, I made up a small block of wood for locating features (similar to a "story stick").

The block was cut to 3-1/2" by 2-1/2". These dimensions were used to mark the length of blank that was to remain square. Two marks were located on one side of the block; these were used to mark the location of parting cuts near the long end. One mark was located on the other side of the block; this was used to mark the location of a parting cut near the short end.

Here is a picture of the first batch.



1. Mount blank on lathe
2. Mark "long" and "short" end of blank using wooden block
3. Turn lathe on
4. Turn square to round transition on long end with spindle gouge
5. Turn blank to round for length of tool rest with roughing gouge
6. Mark two parting cuts by holding block against round section up to transition and using pencil.
7. Turn details at long end using spindle gouge
8. Move rest to other end of spindle and repeat the sequence using the other side of my layout block.
9. Move tool rest to center of spindle
10. Turn taper between details using roughing gouge
11. Turn lathe off

By the end of the job; I was completing this sequence in less than 10 minutes. A job like this once in a while helps to pay for the toys!

August 23, 24 & 25th, 2013

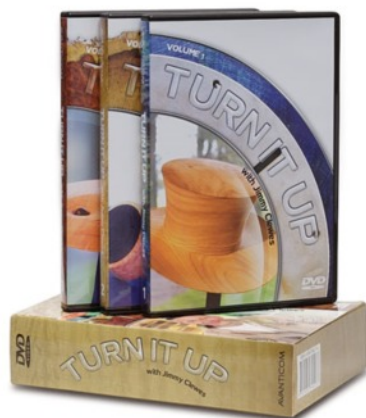
