The Prez Says:



Hello ET Turners,

NEVER STAND IN FRONT OF YOUR LATHE WHEN YOU TURN IT ON WITH WOOD MOUNTED-I was recently turning a large plum root ball, about 18" in diameter. The roots were all convoluted around the ball and I knew I could have some interesting voids in a hollow vessel. I also knew I had to be sure the pieces would all connect around the piece so it would not fall apart after turning. I spent some time trying to fill and glue some of the gaps to make it



stronger. I mounted it between centers using a large spur drive and started turning, forming a tenon on what I wanted to be the bottom. A large chuck gripped the tenon so I could shape the vessel. Hollow turning went well using a hollowing system to control the torque. Occasionally, I noticed the entire piece was producing ghost patterns when viewing the turning edge,

meaning it was out of round. Resetting it in the chuck seemed to remove the ghosts. The shape produced an upper corner that was difficult to hollow, especially since the many voids allowed easy viewing of this thicker wall. I was just about to the desired wall thickness when after inspecting and measuring with calipers, I turned the lathe on for one more hollowing cut. As the lathe spun-up, **POW**, the piece blew apart into 2 huge flying chunks and one still in the chuck (see photo). As always, I was standing off to the side of the piece; otherwise, I would have had a trip to the hospital. It is really scary how fast it happens, how fast the pieces fly and with how much force they hit the floor (something about mass times acceleration).

As I said in the beginning -- **NEVER STAND IN FRONT OF YOUR LATHE WHEN YOU TURN IT ON WITH WOOD MOUNTED---**
ALWAYS STAND TO THE SIDE.

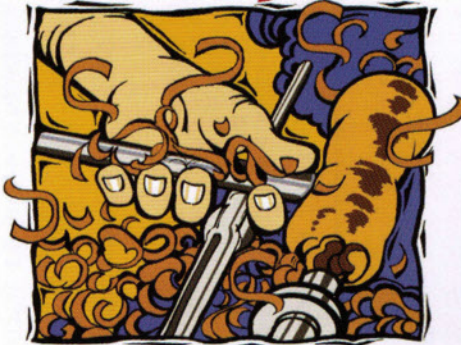

WOOD WORLD & SWAT AT IT AGAIN

Beads of Courage is a nationwide program to provide motivation and encouragement to youngsters by recognizing significant milestones in children's progress through the treatments necessary in their fights against illnesses like cancer, heart disease, burns, etc.

There are 9 hospitals throughout Texas and Oklahoma participating in the program and they could use the help of the folks coming to **SWAT**. These kids need a place to store their treasure-trove of beads, and that's where you come in.

Come to **SWAT** on August 26 in Waco with as many of your personally turned 6" to 12" diameter lidded boxes as you can. All these donated boxes will go to the kids after the winners have been announced.

WoodWorld, Dallas' premier hardwood dealer and a long time vendor at **SWAT**, will again present the artists of the three best pieces, as judged by a committee of our vendors, with gift certificates as follows:

First Place	\$100 gift certificate
Second Place	\$75 gift certificate
Third Place	\$50 gift certificate

In 2010 WoodWorld also took the initiative of recruiting other vendors to pitch in so that the total incentive for the best three entries easily exceeded **\$500!** We are continuing that practice this year and we already have 11 vendors committed to adding to the prize fund and more will surely follow suit, so the prize amounts will not be finalized until later but we fully expect the prizes to eclipse the amounts last year. We're also going to expand the number of prizes to encourage as much participation as possible in this wonderful project, always keeping in mind the recipients of these boxes. This year, the vendors will be offering first, second, and third prizes along with two honorable mentions. The minimum prize amount will be \$50 in vendor cash or merchandise. To further encourage participation, each piece that is entered and has not won one of the 5 judged prizes will entitle the owner to one ticket that will be placed in a drawing for a minimum of one, and maybe more, \$50 prizes.

SWAT 2011 is less than 3 months off, so it's best to start working on your entries and participate in this most worthwhile effort!

All participants will leave with a warm spot in their hearts, knowing that they brightened up the day of a child whose days sure could use some more sunshine.

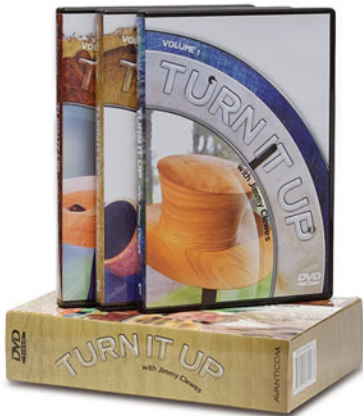
