Editor's Notes

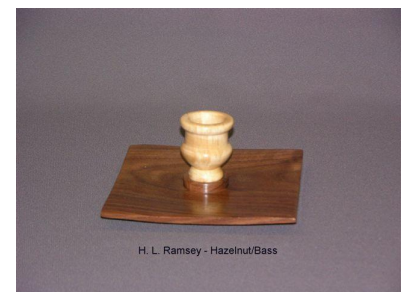
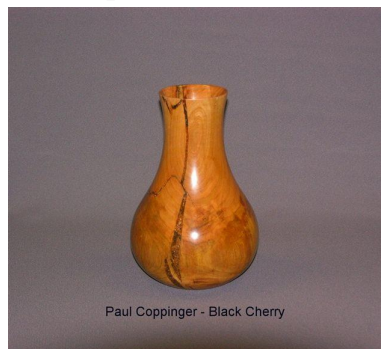

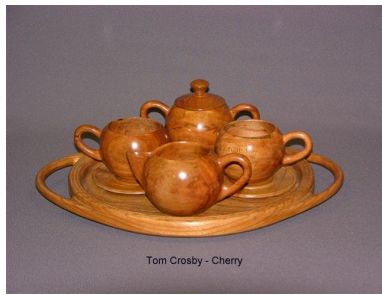

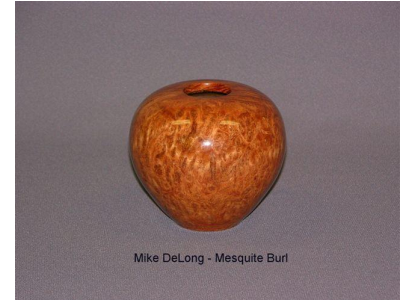

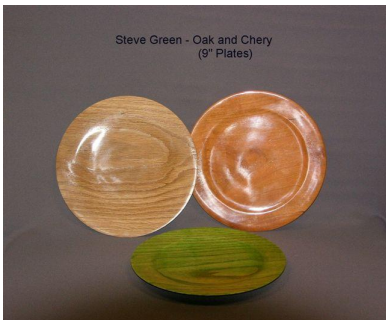

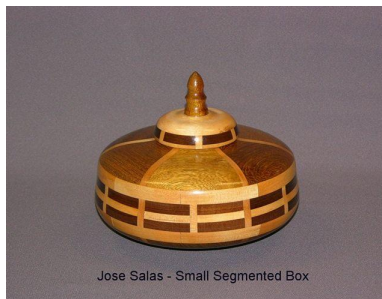

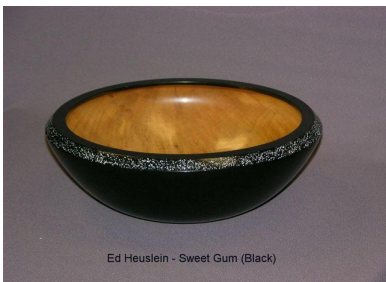
