SWAT 2012 Instant Gallery was another successful effort by the members of East Texas Woodturners Club that set up and managed the gallery. This year the Gallery received 504 items submitted by 132 artists for the regular IG with another 100 items donated by 99 artists to **Beads of Courage**, and 38 items by 37 artists for the **2 for 1 Raffle**. This represents a total of 642 items displayed in the Gallery.

Certainly this would not have happened without the effort of the ETW members. Thanks for your time and work in making the Instant Gallery one of the high points of the 2012 SWAT Symposium.

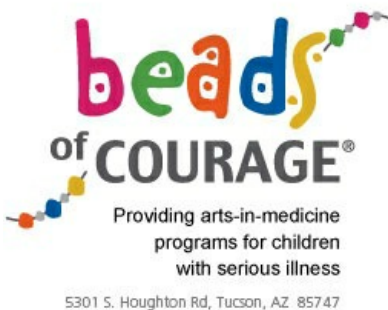

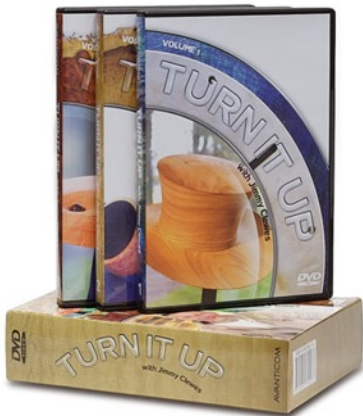
